Organization Summary

Cultural Leadership is a nonprofit organization dedicated to developing a diverse group of youth, and their families, into social justice changemakers who advocate for equitable and just practices. We do this by facilitating intensive leadership programming that explores the strengths and oppressions of our communities through the lenses of Black and Jewish experiences. Our goal is to provide participants the tools and skills necessary to recognize and resolve issues of discrimination and inequity, thereby creating a cadre of leaders who will help build a better world.

We are seeking an organized individual who is passionate about social change, has a growth mindset and thrives in collaborative environments.

Program Summary

The Middle School Leadership Program is a 10-month-long experience for middle school students (7, 8, and 9th grade) that develops students into civic leaders and social justice changemakers. The program includes 8 Sunday afternoon programs (2:00- 6:00pm, January 22, February 19, March 5, April 16, May 14, June 4, Sept 10, and October 15) where students engage in material related to Black history, culture, and identity, Jewish history, culture, and identity, and social justice issues. The Middle School Leadership Program's Changemaker Immersion Trip will take place August 6-8, 2023 outside of St. Louis.

Position Summary

Cultural Leadership staff facilitate program curriculum, lead students on field trips, and build meaningful relationships with them.

The Middle School Leadership Program Facilitator is expected lead, facilitate, and support all 8 Sunday programs as well as the Changemakers Immersion Weekend Trip August 6-8, 2023 outside of St. Louis where they'll also serve as a chaperone.

Responsibilities

- Learn Cultural Leadership's Middle School Program curriculum, including attending an orientation training
- Facilitate programming to middle school students, including engaging students in presentations, activities, and discussions on social justice issues such as systems of oppression, identity and intersectionality, bias, racism, Antisemitism, and taking action as social justice leaders
- Lead students in large group, small group, and 1-on-1 conversations as well as in journaling prompts
- Collaborate with facilitation team on plans for each program, including creating agendas, deciding team roles, and brainstorming ideas for sessions
- Assist with set up, clean up, and other logistics during each program
- Take responsibility for each student's health and safety during all programming, including field trips
